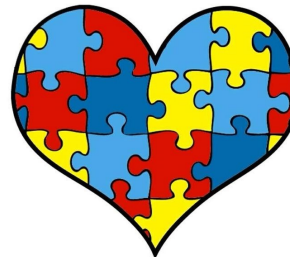
To assist families and help identify their needs by providing:
